Qualifications and Requirements

Qualifications:

1. Must be a resident of Burlington County.
2. Must have completed her sophomore, junior or senior year in high school, or must have completed same home school level requirements.
3. Should be a member of/or have an interest in one or more of the following:
 - Home Economics
 - 4-H
 - Grange
 - Living/Working on a farm or farm market
 - FFA
 - Girl Scouts
 - Preservation of Agriculture in Burlington County
 - Ecology or land preservation
 - Horticulture or gardening

Requirements:

1. Essay and Application (see attachments)
2. Two photographs for use in publicity before the fair. The photo must be a school yearbook type photo.
3. Pageant rehearsal to be determined by Director.
4. You will need an escort such as a father, grandfather, brother, friend, etc.
5. The winner will be required to:
 - Make appearances at the 2017 Burlington County Farm Fair during the Fair: July 19-22, 2017.
 - Make appearances during the 2017-2018 year at Farm Fair-related activities and events.
 - Be present for the crowning of next year's queen in July 2018.

Competition Information and Suggestions

Competition Information:

Contestants will be scored in the following categories, worth ten points each:

1. Poise
2. Appearance
3. Personality
4. Essay (scored by a separate panel of judges)

Suggestions for Contestants:

1. Wear an appropriate summer dress, along with suitable jewelry.
2. Makeup may be applied a little heavier than normal, and hair may be best worn in an “up-do”, since it can be very hot under the stage lights.
3. Wedged heels work best at the fair grounds and on stage.
3. Even if you’re nervous, try to smile and have fun!
4. Remember to stand up straight to show good posture and poise.
6. When answering questions from the Master of Ceremonies, take a second to think about your answer, then answer slowly and clearly. This will be your time to show your poise, personality and intelligence to the judges.
5. Your talents and hobbies are just as important as your physical appearance. The question segment is your opportunity for you to shine for the judges while politely bragging about your accomplishments!
